Two kinds of bears



Polar Bears

1. _____
Polar bears are strong animals. They live in the arctic tundra. They are the top of the food chain and can survive swimming in the chilly water of the Arctic Ocean.

They can swim as fast as ten kilometers per hour. Adult polar bears can weigh about 500 kg (770-1500 lbs) and can measure about 3m.

2. _____
But the North Pole is a cold terrible place to live. Six out of ten polar bear cubs die before they are one year old. The main causes of death are starvation and hunting by humans.

Polar bears typically have two cubs. Though the mother will sometimes kill one cub if she is very hungry.

3. _____
The polar bears are skilled hunters. They catch seals and other animals in the Arctic Ocean. Some researchers think that polar bears are just as smart as chimpanzees.

4. _____
The scientific name for polar bears means "sea bear". Polar bears are sometimes called sea bears because they can swim in the sea.



Panda Bears

5. _____
Panda Bears are rare animals that live in the temperate rainforests of China. They are an endangered species; are left in the wild.

Most pandas live in the bamboo forests, lowlands too, but if destroyed their home there anymore.

6. _____
Panda bears are herbivorous animals that only eat: is 99% bamboo. In fact, they like to eat bamboo leaves, stems and bamboo as well.

7. A Difficult Beginning
Pandas are very small. They weigh only about 10 grams, that's smaller than a glass of milk. And they are completely helpless because they are blind when they are born.

The panda has a body shape typical of bears. It has black fur on its ears, nose, legs, arms, shoulders and around the eyes. The rest of the animal's coat is white.
Scientists aren't sure how long these animals live but they think they can live to about 30-35 years old.

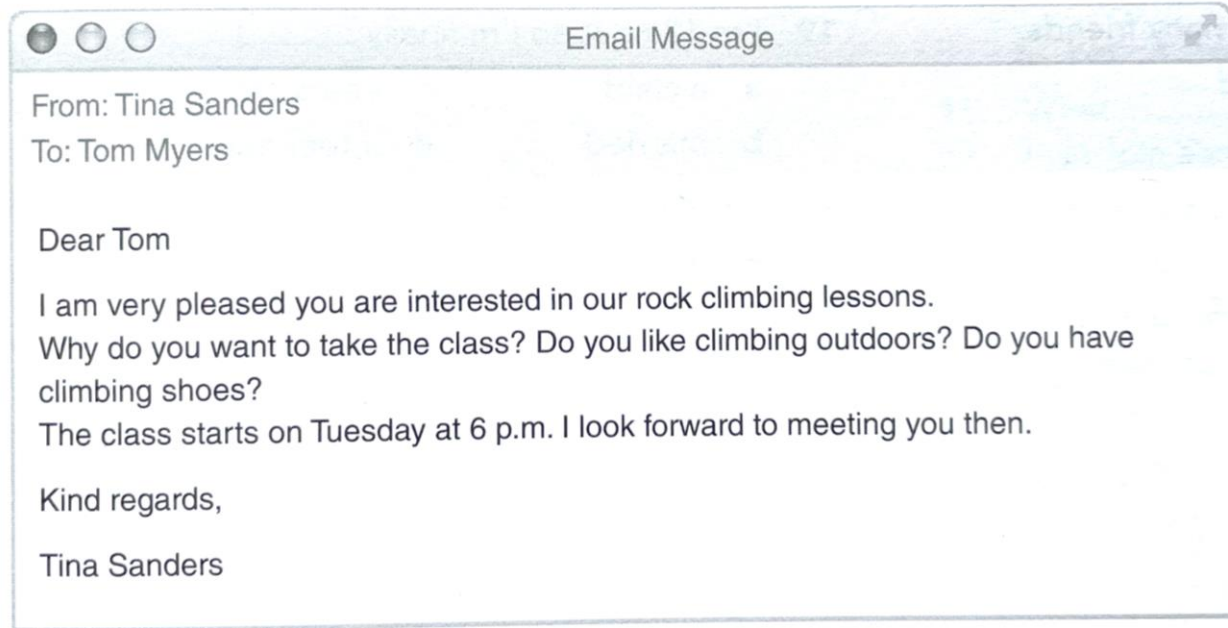

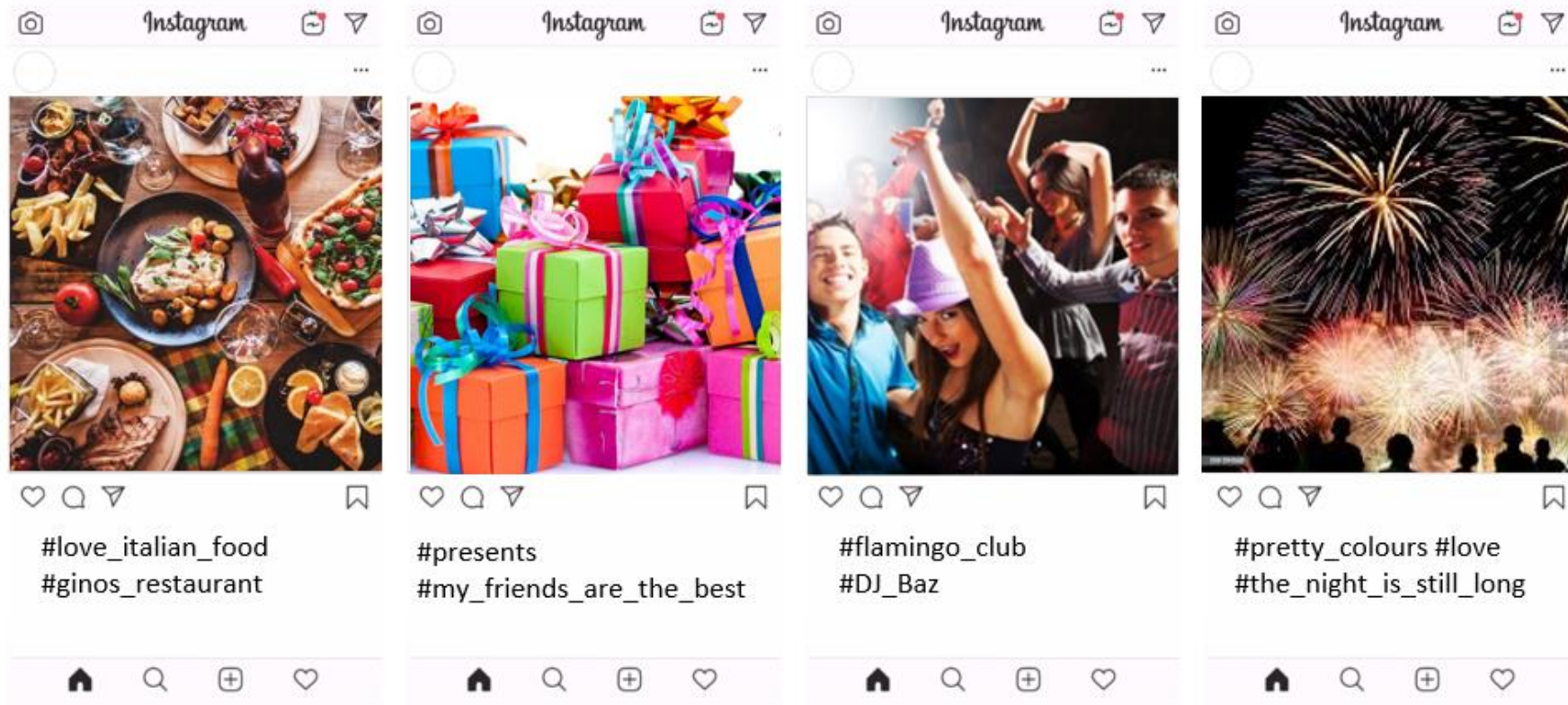
